- 1. Infant (under 5), 2. Junior (5-16), 3. Adult, 4. Friends and Family, 5. Individual Please Note:
  - All registered parade entries are to gather at Waterbeach Primary School as directed when you arrive on the site, (*Please note that the exact area allocated for each group to form up is subject to change depending on weather conditions*)
  - Order of assembly and location in the parade will be communicated once all entries are in.
  - Judging will commence at approximately 1.45pm and all entries need to be in position prior to this time. Judging will also take place during the parade
  - Parade will leave the school grounds at 2pm
  - The Parade will travel via; High Street, Greenside, Chapel Street, St Andrews Hill, Way Lane, Cattells Lane, High Street, Greenside and finish in the arena on the village green. (This is subject to change depending on weather conditions.)
  - Parade presentations will be made in the arena on the village green at the end of the parade at approximately 2.45pm
  - Each parade entry is required to provide a parade marshal. They must attend a briefing with
    the parade organisers when your group arrives at the Primary School. Adults walking with
    children's groups in the parade are not counted as marshals as they are responsible for the
    children in their care and therefore additional cover is required. Hi-Vis vests are provided for all
    marshals.
  - Groups may provide Music in keeping with their theme during the Parade. Not during assembly at the school or on the green please.
  - All groups must have robust safeguarding procedures in place to ensure the care and protection of all members of their group.
  - All marshals must read the information and emergency procedures document (circulated at least 1 week prior to the day of the parade) and sign in on the day of the parade.

The Feast Committee would like to emphasise how important it is to ensure that there are no accidents whilst the procession is in motion. The Feast Committee cannot accept liability for negligence on the part of organisers of parade entries. Please ensure your own safety and that of members of your group.
